Unfortunately, we have a duty under the law to when we look at the evidence provided, and we did not receive very much evidence, as taxpayers in Wyandotte County, we would -- we would like to see enough of our dollars spent to provide the evidence that perhaps could have been collected and was not provided.

And we would encourage whoever's in power to make those decisions to put those resources forth so that we do have all the facts perhaps for this case or for others like it.
